

This is the entire unedited speech that President John F. Kennedy gave at the Waldorf-Astoria Hotel (New York City) on April 27, 1961, entitled, "The President and the Press," before the American Newspaper Publishers Association. In his speech he warns the press and America to be on the lookout for the exact events that happened after his death under the Bush Administration with the false flag of state sponsored terrorism. This speech should have shocked and chilled Americans to the bone and made them alert and on guard for the future. Unfortunately, Kennedy died trying to warn us.
